Sports with a cost

Indoor Soccer – 42 places

Location: Weston Creek Indoor Centre

Depart School: 1.20 pm

Travel: Bus

Total Cost for 7 sessions: \$74.50 (This includes bus transport and coaching)

Tennis – 30 places

Location: Weston Creek Tennis Courts.

Depart School: 1.20 pm

Travel: Bus

Total Cost for 7 lessons: \$32.50 (This includes bus transport and coaching)

Sporting Schools (No Cost)

Our school has received a sporting grant from the Australian Government to offer both sports below free of charge.

Basketball - 30 places

Location: Outdoor Basketball Court, Chapman Primary School

Over the course of the 7 weeks students will learn a variety of skills involved in playing basketball. The students will also play games of basketball. Students who have their own basketball can bring it along each week.

Cricket - 30 Places

Location: Chapman Oval

Over the course of the 7 weeks students will learn a variety of skills involved in playing cricket. The students will also play mini games of cricket. Students who have their own equipment can bring it along each week.

Touch Football - 30 Places

Location: Chapman Primary Oval

Over the course of the 7 weeks students will learn a variety of skills involved in playing touch football. The students will also play games of touch football.

Location: Chapman Primary Hall

The program incorporates a variety of physical activities and aerobic movement challenges.

Golf with Mr Howell – 30 places

Location: Chapman Primary School Oval

The game of golf is one of the most popular and relaxing of all outdoor sports. Join Mr Howell for an enjoyable afternoon of golfing activities for all skill levels.

Bush Walking – 30 Places

Location: Cooleman Ridge

Come and join Mrs Lane & Mr Day for a great opportunity to explore the Cooleman Ridge. Each week the students will have an opportunity to explore a different section of the Ridge.

Skipping – 30 Places

Location: Chapman Primary (Senior Blacktop)
