Donations large and small are greatly appreciated and can be deposited in the Tombola box at the front office.



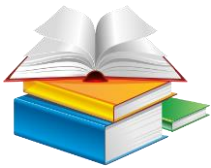

- Petite chicks of mixed of colours – splash black white blues
- Will grow up to be super fluffy and small friendly “pets with benefits” if handled regularly, laying about 4 little eggs each week with pretty pearl finish that are very tasty. Most chooks will not lay in winter.

All are chicks are sold as..

- Unsexed
- Will need to be kept warm under a heat lamp, a hot light bulb or in a fish tank with a reptile heat pad AT NIGHT IF TEMPS DROP. But they are almost there. You can probably improvise with things you already have to get through this time.
- **Must buy more than one chick because they are flock animals and will die without a buddy from the same hatch/same age.**
- An info sheet, after sales advice and a small amount of chick feed supplied to each buyer as part of the sale price just to get you started!
- Please note that these guys, like all chickens, are easy targets for foxes, rats, any hunting bird, cats and dogs. The must have very secure housing even in suburbia.
