We have organised a range of activities that will engage and challenge children in developing new skills, enhancing existing skills and/or learning a new sport. We encourage all parents and carers to discuss the options outlined with your child and return the form with full payment by the end week 1 term 2.

Sports with a cost

Indoor Soccer – 42 places

Location; Weston Creek Indoor Centre

Depart School 1.20 pm

Total Cost for 7 sessions: \$74.50 (This includes bus transport and coaching)

Taekwondo (By a qualified instructor) - 30 places

Location: Chapman Primary School Hall

A Korean self-defence martial art that involves a series of movements including kicking, punching and blocking. The classes are safe for all students and will not teach them to hurt others. They will practise Taekwondo in a safe and friendly environment and learn respect for themselves and for each other.

Total Cost for 7 lessons: \$41.00

Tennis – 30 places

Location: Weston Creek Tennis Courts.

Total Cost for 7 lessons: \$32.50 (This includes bus transport and coaching)

Sporting Schools (No Cost)

Our school has received a sporting grant from the Australian Government to offer both sports below free of charge.

Orienteering-30 Places

Location: Chapman Primary School

Over the course of the 7 weeks students will learn a variety of skills involved in orienteering. The aim of orienteering is to navigate your way around a course with a series of numbered checkpoints called controls. The course is marked on a map with coloured symbols, explained by a legend.

School Sport without cost

Miss Tirzins' Boot Camp Blast – 50 places

Location: Chapman Primary

The program incorporates a variety of physical activities and challenges that will focus on team building, effective communication, respect for others and better awareness of themselves.

Mrs Lane's Yoga Zone - 30 Places

Location: Chapman Primary

Each session will promote healthy living and the tools to deal with daily challenges. Yoga promotes flexibility and meditation, in addition provides individuals with the tools to deal with daily challenges.

AFL – 36 Places

Location: Chapman Primary

Mr Campbell will run an AFL round robin. During each session students will have the chance to practise the skills of kicking, hand passing and catching in a game situation.

Dancing – 30 Places

Location: Chapman Primary

Mrs Francis's dancing program will be catered for all levels of ability. No prior experience will be required.

Tri-sports – 40 Places

Location: Chapman Primary

Mr Day will run a tri-sport afternoon consisting of soccer, netball and oz-tag. Each week will focus on one of the three sports.

No refunds for non-attendance will be given unless a doctor's certificate is supplied.

Bus is not refundable – only lessons missed.
