Chapman Primary School

An effective communication system is a powerful leadership and collaboration tool. It enables the school to engage with, motivate and support parents and families.

In a primary school, communication with parents is critical to address risks associated with disengaged and uninformed parents.

Communication Capability

A communication capability ensures discipline in communication channels, improves the quality of information and establishes mechanisms for evaluating and improving performance.

Parent communication is centred around five core elements: Departmental Policy; Whole-of-Chapman Primary School Strategy; Coordinated Teachers' Messages; Communication Channels; and Continuous Improvement.

Communication Principles

Clarity of purpose

- Teachers connect parents and students to the organisation's vision and purpose.
- Parents and students understand how they contribute to the school.

Information sharing

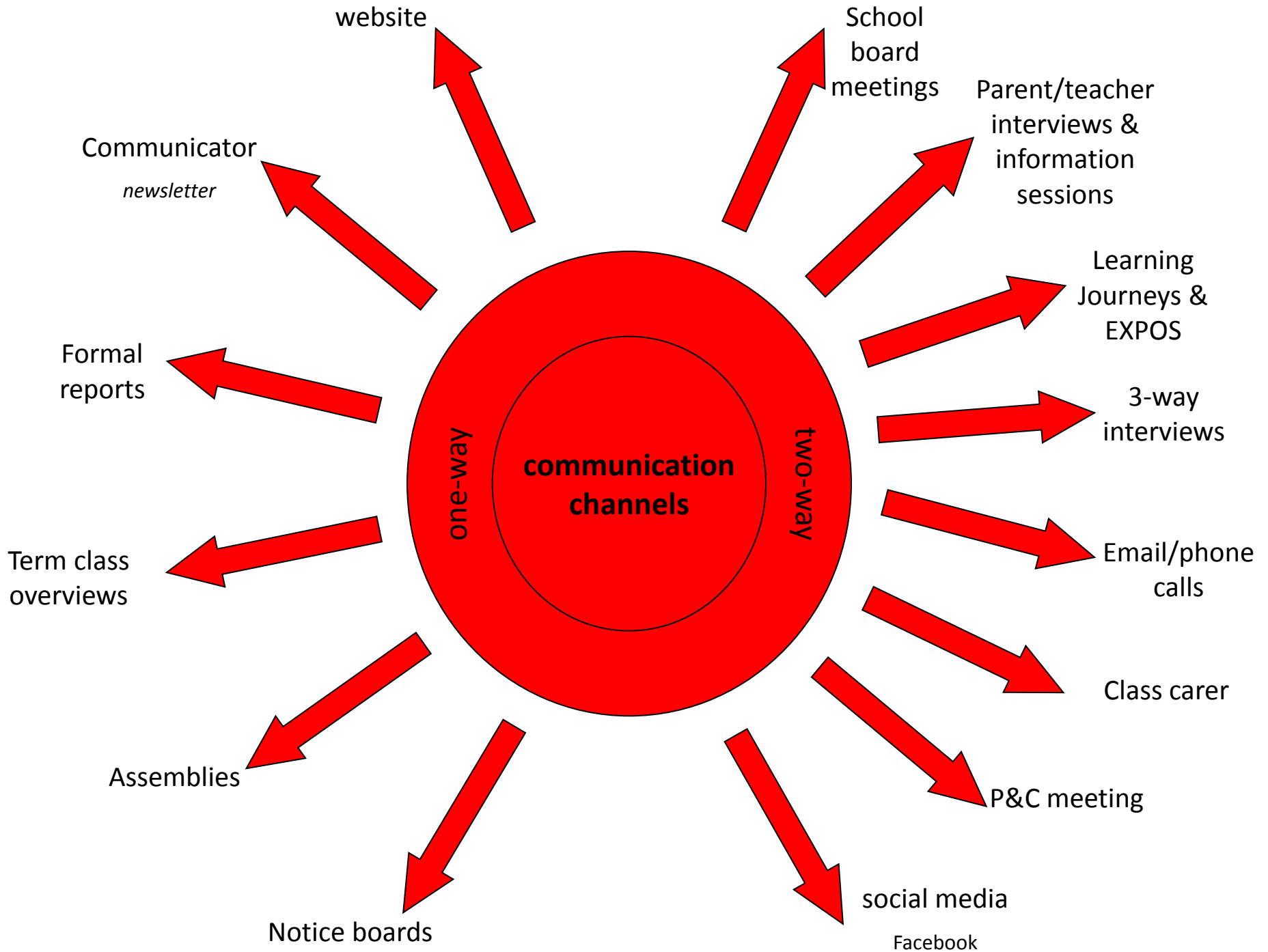
- Parents are informed, and equally they are heard.
- Teachers provide safe opportunities for families to discuss, debate and engage with them.
- Core strategic messages cascade from the Principal to teachers to students and parents.

Effective interfaces

- A variety of communication methods are employed to ensure messages reach every teacher, student and parent.

Leadership behaviour

- Teachers demonstrate a commitment to communicate and embed communication in day-to-day behaviour.
- Communication is authentic, transparent and proactive.
