5/6 Incursion – Forensic Science Workshop- A Case of Discovery

This Forensic Science workshop incursion aims to encourage a love of and curiosity in Science amongst students and show them how Science plays an important role in the world outside the classroom.

Presenters bring a real-to-life crime scene investigation to the school, set up a series of forensic evidence experiments and lead the students through the case while they learn how chemistry, physics and biology can help to solve crimes.

A Case of Discovery

An Auction House Robbery seems to have gone well for a gang of thieves who have made off with rare coins, gold, and jewellery. Students will examine the crime scene, take their own fingerprints, create coin impressions, build a DNA model, crack a safe code and much more during this investigation.
