Sports with a cost

Indoor Soccer – 42 places

Location: Weston Creek Indoor Centre

Depart School 1.20 pm

Travel: Bus

Total Cost for 7 sessions: \$71.00 (This includes bus transport and coaching)

Lawn Bowls (barefoot bowls) - 32 places

Location: Weston Creek Labor Club

Like to walk around without shoes? Want to try something new? Then lawn bowls is for you. You will walk to the Weston Creek Labor Club, kick off your shoes and roll bowls down the green.

Total Cost for 7 lessons: \$32.00

Tennis – 30 places

Location: Weston Creek Tennis Courts.

Gymnastics – 40 Places

Location: Chapman Primary School Hall

The program involves games, circuits and challenges which are skill focused and can be adapted to the needs of the individual group.

Total cost for 7 weeks: \$10.00

Sporting Schools (No Cost)

Our school has received a sporting grant from the Australian Government to offer both sports below free of charge.

Baseball-30 Places

Location: Chapman Oval

Over the course of the 7 weeks students will learn a variety of skills involved in playing baseball. The students will also play games of baseball. Students who have their own equipment can bring it along each week.

Rugby Union (Game On) -30 Places

Location: Chapman Primary Oval

The objective of Game On is to educate students through the values of Rugby – those being teamwork, passion, integrity, respect and discipline – to develop skills both in the classroom and on the field. All sessions will be non-contact.

School Sport without cost

Miss Tirzins' Boot Camp Blast – 50 places

Location: Chapman Primary

The program incorporates a variety of physical activities and challenges that will focus on team building, effective communication, respect for others and better awareness of themselves.

Buroinjin - 36 Places

Location: Chapman Primary Oval

Students will have the opportunity to play a running and ball passing game. The aim is for a player of one team to hit the stumps with the buroinjin (ball).

Skipping – 30 Places

Location: Chapman Primary Music Room

Miss Williamson is running a program where students can learn lots of new skills and tricks while skipping.

No refunds for non-attendance will be given unless a doctor's certificate is supplied.
